Rules and Guidelines:

- All rules are governed by USGA and Riverside Golf Course Local rules of play.
- Each golfer must have a set of golf clubs and register at the Pro Shop before playing.
- Golfers will practice common courtesy and observe all rules of etiquette at all times.
- Players are responsible for any damage they do to the golf course, golf course equipment, carts, or other golf course property.
- Proper golf attire is required on the course and when utilizing practice facilities.
- We are a soft spike facility. Metal spike or other athletic shoes with rubber spikes or cleats are prohibited.
- Repair all divots and ball marks and rake bunkers after use.
- Practice on the course is prohibited, unless specifically authorized by the Head Golf Professional.
- Juniors under the age of 12 years must be accompanied by an adult at all times, unless other arrangements have been made with the Head Golf Professional.
- Alcoholic beverages consumed on the premises must be purchased from the golf shop in accordance with standing TABC license.

Pace of Play

- An acceptable pace of play is defined as completing 9 holes of play within 2 hours and 15 minutes or 18 holes within 4 hours and 30 minutes.
- Groups failing to comply with the pace of play policy may be asked to pick up and move ahead to the next hole, allow trailing groups to play through, or may be asked to discontinue play.

Cart Rules:

- Observe the 90 degree rule when entering/exiting fairways and return to cart paths when directed by course signage.
- Valid Driver's License is required for cart use. Only two persons allowed per cart.
- Only two carts per group of four players or three carts per group of five players. Pro Shop staff reserves the right to pair players to reduce turf traffic. Fivesomes must be approved by the Head Golf Professional.
- Privately owned carts are welcomed, but must be equipped with turf style tires.
- Handicap flags can be utilized, but must remain 15 yards from putting surfaces and tee boxes. Head Golf Professional reserves the right to restrict carts to cart path only, to protect the golf course conditions.

Inclement Weather

- The Head Golf Professional, or staff under their direction, assumes responsibility to halt play during poor weather conditions.
